We have grown in leaps and bounds on the account of your consistent sponsorship, and despite the economic challenges, we surpassed our entire 2023 full year givings in just 6 months of 2024.

Thanks to your generosity, we have achieved significant milestones:

- Raised a total of NGN13,054,500 and \$142 (January to June 2024).
- Recorded circa 1,200 souls led to Christ.
- Supported approximately 70 children in school.
- Distributed 100 Bibles to believers in the north.
- Provided NGN1,077,000 in relief aid to displaced Plateau believers.
- Successfully opened our corporate bank account.

Thank you very much for giving to the Lord and His work.



God has been mightily faithful. In the 1st half of 2024, we saw our reach increase from 12 to 16 Nigerian states and from 5 to 9 African Countries. Till we have at least 1 missionary in every country of the world and the zeal of the Lord will perform it.





The testimony of Mission Ally overtime has remained that our God is good! God continues to blow our minds and shows us that He is mighty through us. So far in the year 2024, we raised #13,054,500 in the first 6 months of this year, this is 0.29% significantly higher than the total 2023 donations (#13,016,426.00) and 104.2% YoY (January-June 2023, #6,383,116.00). However, we believe that God is just starting with us and so we will leave it to you to take a wild guess of how much we would have raised for missionaries with your support and donations by the end of the year. From your lips to God's ears.

As at the same period last year, our average amount raised from monthly contributions stood at \\$1,063,852.67. This has now increased by over 100% to an average of \\$2,175,750 monthly. Again, this is due to the increase in contributor count from 103 as at June 2023, to 150 in June 2024.

All funds received have been used to support 35 missionaries across 15 Nigerian states and 9 International mission stations.

According to the Open Door World Watch List 2024, Nigeria ranks 6th on the list of "50 most dangerous countries to be a Christian" as well as the most violent country in the world to be a Christian.

Between late December 2023 & early January 2024, over 140 siblings in certain areas of Plateau State were brutally murdered in attacks led by suspected extremists among Fulani Muslim herdsman

As a result of these attacks, surviving believers were displaced out of their homes and livelihood. In collaboration with Mission Enablers International & Nigerian Evangelical Mission Association, we provided relief support to these believers as seen in the images below

We are delighted to share with you the incredible impact of your generous contributions over the past six months. Your support has enabled us to bring hope, education, and the love of God to countless individuals and communities in Northern Nigeria. This report highlights the life-changing work we have accomplished together.

Souls Saved: 501 Villages Visited: 37

Partnerships: We strengthened our collaboration with 10 local missionary organizations, ensuring that our efforts are culturally sensitive and sustainable.

Evangelical Outreach: Our evangelical outreach programs have brought the message of Christ to 1223 individuals, leading to 400 new converts who are now actively participating in their local churches.

Medical Missions: We conducted 3 medical camps offering free healthcare services, vaccinations, and health education to over 173 people. These efforts have saved lives and improved the overall health of the communities we serve.

School Fees Program: We provided school fees for 47 children, allowing them to receive quality education and build a brighter future

One of the significant challenges we face is the need for committed local missionaries. While our partnerships with local organizations have been fruitful, the demand for dedicated workers continues to grow. We are actively seeking and training new missionaries, but we need your prayers for their perseverance and commitment.

We really want to testify of the great and wonderful things that happened to us as a result of your support in the first half of the year.

Firstly, in January when schools resumed for the second term after the Christmas and New Year festivities, our children returned to school as usual. However, as the term progressed, their fees needed to be paid. Uncertain about where the fees would come from, we turned our faces to God alone, so when your support came, we knew it was an answer prayers. We joyfully paid their fees and they were able to return to school void of distraction from their teachers over school fees debt

Secondly, due to the recent economic crises in Nigeria, we decided to engage in small-scale farming to reduce our dependence on buying foodstuff. While planning, we trusted God to provide the resources to make this happen and through your support, we were able to buy yam seedlings for planting fertilizers to enhance the crop yield

Furthermore, your support has been instrumental in providing support for the missionary children under our care. Your support has helped us navigate the increasing inflation that has made feeding difficult. Your contribution has enabled us provide food to the family which has helped us teach the children that God can be trusted as they see the evidence through your support. Souls are saved, smokers and alcohol addictions delivered, adulterous ones saved, expecting mothers conceived, prisoners released, academic breakthroughs for the children in the church, possessed set free in the name of Jesus Christ, many have believed the Gospel and started attending church, some are now workers and evangelists

We organised a power-packed program and it was a success. We held Discipleship classes, baptised about 8 brethren, carried out outreaches carried out although we still need more finances for outreaches. We also need more hands in the field as some pastors have left the villages and run back to the cities because the villages have no churches and they worship idols.

We thank God for what He is doing and continue to do in the name of Our Lord Jesus Christ amen.



MISSIONARIES' TESTIMONIES

In the past, as an apologetic Hausa Muslim, I was staunchly opposed to the Gospel of Salvation. However, in His boundless mercy, God found me, brought me into His kingdom, and ordained me to reach out to the lost, just as He reached out to me.

In response to this calling, I now serve as a missionary across various mission fields in Northern Nigeria. I frequently travel to these communities, following the Lord's guidance through prayer and the leading of the Holy Spirit.

Over the past four years, since my connection with Mission Ally, God has empowered me to plant about 20 churches among the KMB people in Niger State. With God's help, I have also raised more than ten full-time missionaries, seven of whom are indigenous KMB. They now serve in different fields under my supervision.

During our last outreach, 107 Muslims accepted Jesus as their Lord and Savior. We now have a resident missionary among them who has started discipling these new believers this month. We are deeply grateful for the amazing work God is doing among them as His kingdom quietly expands

In another development, God has used us to bring the Gospel to the least-reached tribes, particularly among the GLW tribes in Kebbi State. One remarkable testimony is a young man, a health service provider, who surrendered his life to Jesus in May 2024. He has joined me in the mission to raise obedient disciples, who in turn will multiply through the Discovery Bible Studies they are trained in. This training is currently ongoing in the Gelawa villages, where God is helping us counter the stronghold of Islam with the message of salvation. It is important to acknowledge that none of this would have been possible without the cheerful and consistent support from Mission Ally. Their unwavering monthly support has been a cornerstone of our mission work.

Since my conversion from Islam, my people have turned against me, denying me access to my four children. My former wife was given in marriage to another Muslim because of my conversion. This was a very challenging time, but God has continually sustained me through the support of His people, allowing me to remain steadfast in my faith despite persecution.

As I answered God's call to join the mission work, Mission Ally's support has provided me with the sustenance needed to stay focused on my mission, despite the difficulties. By God's faithfulness, my children are now turning to me for their needs, including their school fees. Mission Ally's support has been instrumental in helping me fulfill my responsibilities as a father. As a result, my children are willing to be with me. By the end of this month, by God's grace, I will be able to bring them back to live with me for their further upbringing in a godly environment, as the Lord leads.





We want to sincerely express our deep appreciation and gratitude for the incredible support Mummy Taiwo has provided to us in the mission field of Nakere. Your support has been a tremendous relief, especially in carrying out our rural programs. This includes initiatives for widows, assistance for the less privileged, payment of school fees for orphans, and providing medical care.

I want to express my profound gratitude to God for choosing me to work in His vineyard, to win souls, and to make disciples for Jesus.

This year has been a truly wonderful and enriching experience. God has been actively working to win souls, make disciples, heal people from various sicknesses and infirmities, and empower them with the Holy Spirit, evidenced by speaking in tongues and prophesying.

Through the generous support of Missions 1 and our partners, especially Mission Ally, I was able to embark on three mission outreaches in Jigawa State, an area predominantly inhabited by Hausa and Fulani Muslims.

By God's grace, many souls were won and discipled to His glory. In one community, even the Sarki (local chief) and the Village Head learned to read in Hausa and accepted Christ. We held our first service together with them, which was a monumental step in their faith journey.

In the JKI community, a lady who had been suffering from chronic ear pain for years, despite numerous hospital visits, was miraculously healed after I prayed for her. Additionally, all the kidnapped victims I prayed for escaped without paying a ransom.

One particularly remarkable testimony involved a pastor's wife and daughter who were kidnapped for over six weeks. After praying for them over the phone, I declared that they would return home within the week without paying a ransom. Miraculously, two days later, they were freed, sharing that the kidnappers had fallen into a deep sleep after eating, allowing all the captives to escape.

Moreover, four individuals who had been unable to walk for over a year were restored to health and began walking immediately after prayer. Another extraordinary case involved a man whose wife and daughter's limbs were paralyzed. After praying for them over the phone in the evening, they woke up completely healed the next morning.

These are just a few of the countless miracles and testimonies God has granted us this year. My family and I are not only well-fed but also able to extend help to others, all thanks to the continuous support from Missions 1 and its partners.

May our God continue to bless you abundantly according to His riches in glory through Christ Jesus our Lord. Amen. Thank you a zillion times!





We thank God for the privilege to continue serving in His vineyard. Here are highlights of our major activities in the first half of 2024.

Field work: We thank God for what he is doing in our fields in CAPRO North West zone. In our work amongst the Fulanis, two of the people being engaged are showing prospects of accepting the gospel. Amongst the KYG people, we have six ongoing discovery bible study (DBS) centres and three persons gave their lives to Christ this year. Through the radio broadcast in our work amongst the BK people, one person surrendered to the Lord. A Fulani man gave his life to Christ in our work amongst the KMB.

Mission prayer group with students: We started two prayer groups amongst the students of CLC, Minna. Basically, we pray every Friday for our fields in the North West Nigeria. We also joined the 30 days of prayer for the Muslim world during the month of Ramadan. We watched missionary story of George Muller in one of our meetings.

Easter Evangelism outreach to Children & Teenagers: Easter Evangelism outreach to children and teenagers was a success to the glory of God. We had a total number of 63 children and 14 were counseled for Salvation. Our target people – the Muslim children were part of the children that responded to the Salvation message. Some of the children have also become a member of our Good News Club.



Despite the hospitalization of the Field Leader who eventually had to undergo surgery, the ASB field planted another church KPN, ASB, but the ban in Okada riding within ASB town affected the number as most of the members who were Okada riders had to relocate back to the north.

However, we are trailing them in their various towns in the North to start reaching out to their Muslim neighbors with the gospel with what they learnt while in ASB. We hope to establish a reverse mission work through this as our ultimate goal is to raise Migrants who will reach back to their people in the North with the gospel. We have received good response from members in two towns from the North. With the remaining members here in ASB, we are continuing with the discipleship training process.

It is our prayer that his recovery is speedy.

We thank the Mission Ally team for sharing with us the passion and burden to encourage and support the educational progress of our young ones in our Churches.

Over 20 students have benefitted from the school fees support we receive from Mission Ally and it had been a blessing to them, whenever the intervention comes. This period it has benefitted our students in the following ways:

- Payment of school fees for 2 pupils in Primary school and 3 students in JHS.
- Support 8 of our SHS students in transport and feeding while in school.
- Support for 2 of our graduating SHS volunteers to purchase admission forms to tertiary school and were eventually admitted.

These stipends support the work from time to time in addition to what their parents can afford have encouraged the students to be able to continue with their education without distractions or discouragement

MR J


My son, was always eager to learn, but we couldn't afford his school fees. Thanks to Mission Ally through RM, he is now in school and excelling. My joy is complete.
