We did it again in 2024. Through your givings, we:

- Raised NGN26,686,600, over 200% of our 2023 donations.

- Recorded over 5,000 miracles of changed desires across Africa
- Raised over NGN2,000,000 for 40 missionary families for Christmas

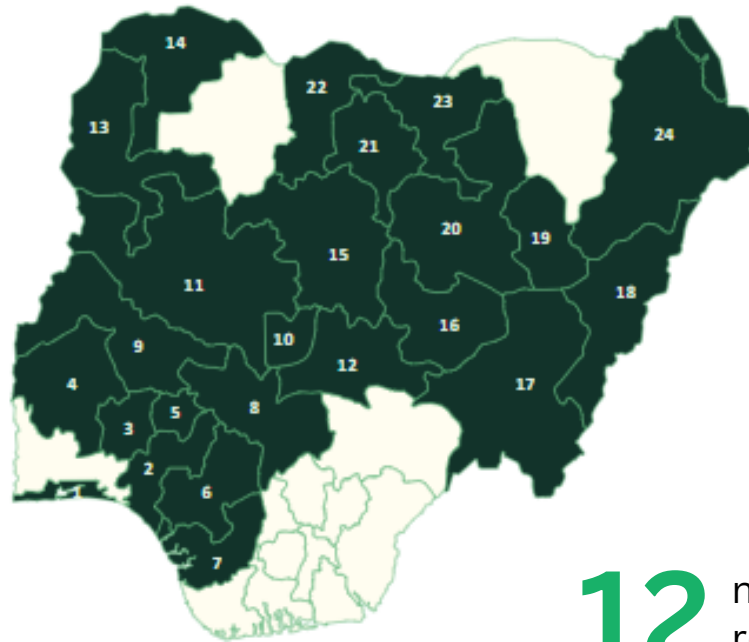

Northern Nigeria.

Decisions for Christ & Discipleship

- **Souls Reached:** By God's grace, we reached 9,434 individuals with the gospel this year through village crusades, evangelistic events, and personal outreach efforts.
- **Souls Saved:** Hallelujah! 3,656 precious souls made decisions for Christ, and many are being disciplined in local churches.
- **Bibles Distributed:** We distributed 2,150 Bibles, surpassing their goal for the year, ensuring that new believers have the Word of God to grow in their faith. Maryam Musa from Northern Nigeria shared, "The Bible I received has become my most treasured possession. I now understand God's promises and have found peace in Jesus Christ."
- **Missionary Pastors Supported:** 15 missionary pastors received financial and material support monthly, empowering them to focus on spreading the gospel.
- **Reconnecting with Pastor Maleur:** After losing contact for years, we reconnected with Pastor Maleur in Chad where the church planted has grown to 70 members, and he shared how your support has sustained his ministry despite challenges.

Challenges Faced in the Mission Field

- **Missionary Discouragement:** Many of our missionaries, like Musa in Northern Nigeria, face physical exhaustion and spiritual battles. Musa shared, "Though I lost my wife this year, God's strength and RCMI's support have kept me pressing forward."

Needs in the Mission Field

- **Difficult Terrain:** Access to remote villages remains a challenge due to poor roads and infrastructure. The need for motorbikes to reach these areas is urgent, as many pastors currently walk for hours to minister to their congregations.

Katsina & Kano States, Nigeria

Decisions for Christ & Discipleship

- **Discipleship:** We launched a discipleship program for Muslim converts, including funding their relocation from dangerous areas, providing food, and supporting them begin new lives.
- **Souls Saved:** Hallelujah! The Lord gave us two (3) converts M, V and A. The last accepted Christ just at the tail end of December last year.
- **Healings:** The Lord healed numerous people of physical illness, emotional wounds, and marital problems. We were able to attend at least 10 persons with emotional instability using the Bible therapy and restored 5 marriages that were at the point of divorce one among which are prepared to join missions training by 10th of January 2025

Testimonies

- Mr and Mrs J were at the verge of divorce, but the Lord used us to restore them back and even help them find life purpose in drawing others unto the Lord
- We supported one of our converts with his fees and welfare in the mission training school. He recently completed his one year training and was inducted as a certified missionary in our agency
- We had a woman with a yearly reoccurring illness, by the grace of God after praying and joining faith, for the first time in October the sickness was healed and has not occurred after
- In September 2024, we had cases of bandits in a community in Katsina and people were running for their lives during that period, the support for September was completely added to the pool of funds to secure a three bedroom house as a shelter and safe haven for displaced persons within the Kankara local government of Katsina state.
- M had a demonic attack in April 2024 where she heard voices pushing her into suicide, the Lord delivered her after much time of consistent prayer and fasting. Today she is completely whole.

North Western Nigeria

Decisions for Christ & Discipleship

- **Discipleship:** We thank God for what he is doing in our fields in CAPRO North West zone.
 - In our work amongst the Fulanis, a man accepted Christ as his Lord and Saviour this year. We are trusting God for the conversion of his entire family.
 - A Fulani man also gave his life to Christ in our work amongst the Kambaris.
 - Amongst the KYG people, we have seven ongoing discovery bible study (DBS) centres and a total of nineteen disciples. A house church was recently planted among the KYG people.
 - BK field now has five secret disciples. We also had a new convert from our work amongst the Bauchi people in Niger state.

Ministry Report

- **Easter Evangelism outreach to Children & Teenagers:** Easter Evangelism outreach to children and teenagers was a success to the glory of God. We had a total number of 63 children and 14 were counseled for Salvation. Our target people - the Muslim children were part of the children that responded to the Salvation message. Some of the children have also become a member of our Good News Club.
- **Children Christmas Evangelical Outreach:** The team typically holds Christmas evangelism outreaches targeted at children, and this year to the glory of God, they were able to reach out to 149 children including our focused people (Muslim children). 28 children were counselled for salvation. Please, join us in prayer that these children will grow in faith and in love of/for God.
- **Fulani Prayer Conference:** In collaboration with some of our partners and other believers, the missionaries working in the Fulani field, had a prayer conference in September to pray for our work amongst the Fulani people and mobilize the church to labour with us as we trust God for the salvation of their souls. It was a two-day meeting that featured exhortation, prayer uproar and a look into the current state of the work and future plans.

- The year 2024 was a great year for the church. The church experienced numerical growth through its mission activities within the community, as two families joined the church's membership, though there are others worshipping with us who have yet to declare their membership. As of today, the adult, youth, and children's population of the church has risen to 62. Some members were baptized after being disciplined. Therefore, we thank God for the spiritual and numerical growth of the church.

Needs in the Mission Field

- **Instruments:** The church is trusting God to buy instruments like speakers, microphone, generator, and musical instrument. As this will enhance worship service of the church.
- **More Hands:** We hope to have more mission partners as this will help the church to meet some her administrative work and to support the church pastor's family who are not under any salary

Decisions for Christ & Discipleship

- **Souls Saved:** To the glory of God, 14 souls were snatched from hell's grip, although most of them returned to the North at the end of the year, we are continually praying for their faith and growth
- **Discipleship:** Hallelujah! We currently have 3 bible study groups with Northerners that meet weekly in bushes due to persecution

Ministry Report

- **Church Planting Projects:** Glory to God, we were able to plant a church this year. It is our prayer that it continues to grow amidst growing persecution

- "I am deeply grateful for the support I have received. It has truly been a blessing, and I recognize it as God's provision for all my needs and the work I do. Thanks to this support, I have been able to pay my rent, access healthcare and get medication."

Decisions for Christ & Discipleship

- **Souls Saved:** By God's grace, about 300 souls got saved across all outreach and evangelism efforts.
- **Souls Filled With The Holy Ghost:** Glory to God! Circa 100 souls were filled with the Holy Ghost with the evidence of speaking in tongues
- The work continued to prosper among the Zaramo and Masai ethnio cultural group of Southern Eastern Pwani region of Tanzania and North East of Tanzania respectively.

Testimonies

- 13 widows got ministered to with foodstuffs and NGN10,000 for each during our outreach in October.
- A Muslim lady got born again, was persecuted but still chosen to follow the Lord Jesus Christ,
- 9 leaders got trained in the school of the Ministry for the whole year.
- We had an outreach for teenagers in December called 'December Camp' and about 115 teenagers were in attendance
- We went on multiple school outreaches.
- By God's grace and with your support we were able consistently feed and cater to 1 orphan and 3 other community children under our care
- We recorded the complete healing of one of our men who used stick to walk, to the glory of God.
- God blessed us with a plot of land to build a place of worship for our disciples, trusting to build on it this year

- **Souls Saved:** By God's grace, about over 20 souls have been saved across all outreach and evangelism efforts.
- **Souls Reached:** Glory to God! The team is reaching over 9,000 people in the 2 villages they are sent to

Ministry Report

- **School of Ministry Graduation:** To the glory of God, over 25 students graduated the school of ministry in 2024
- **Ministry to Teenagers:** Typically, children and teenagers in that region are akin to vices, we obeyed the leading of God to reach out to them and we got 11 of them saved to the glory of God
- **Ministry to Drunkards at the Bar:** The Lord opened an avenue to sharing the Gospel in a local bar, and to the glory of God, we have witnessed 10 conversions including the owner of the bar and his wife
- **Mother & Child Intervention:** The ministry reached out to a young single mother, Simi (21) and her 2 brothers Francis & Destiny who lost their father to Fulani Militia and an eloped mother.

Needs

- **Prayers:** There is a hotspot in the village known for robberies and kidnappings almost on a weekly basis, Pray that the Lord makes the village uncondusive for the bandits
- **Simi & Her Brothers:** Simi wants to learn hairdressing and her brothers need to go back to school, however, they need rehabilitation as they are currently addicted to drugs.
- **Chairs:** The new church in GRP needs 120,000 to buy new chairs
- Scholarships for their children in the university
- **Development of the Ministry Building:** 7 units of solar generating sets for pumping water, admin/library bloc, hospitality, staff quarters, 3 units of students hostel = N8.4m
- A strong vehicle for evangelistic work in rural area, ask the LORD to provide one for us

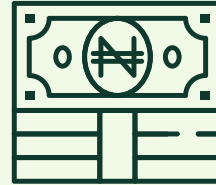

145 of the children we support are in Primary School, 20 of them are in secondary school, and the remaining 6 are in tertiary institutions across the continent

We support pupil and students across 5 states (Niger, Nasarawa, Bauchi, Ife, Adamawa) and 2 countries (Nigeria & Ghana)

We have numerous testimonies from the parents and guardians of the children we support, but this one is dear to our hearts:

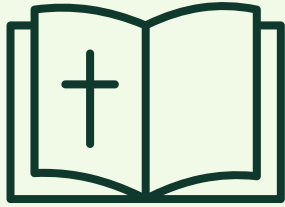

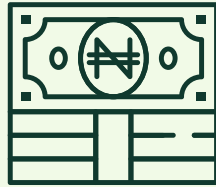

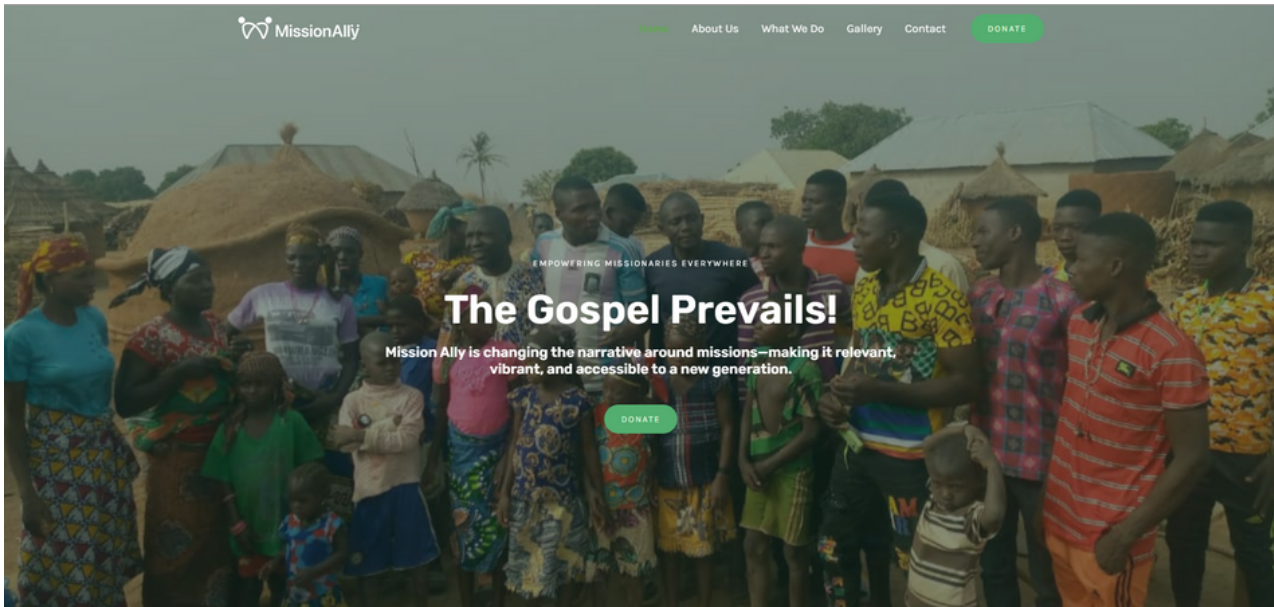
The missionaries we support are within the 40-50s age range and typically reside in areas where it is both difficult and expensive to obtain proper healthcare.
