What a joy to write to you this first half of the year 2025. I am particularly grateful for your sacrificial love evidenced by your continuous commitment to the spread of the Gospel through the work at Mission Ally. In spite and despite, you have remained steadfast in ensuring the continued welfare of missionaries, some: their children, health and to see Bibles in the hands of new converts. A lot of people and their families offer praises to God month-in and out because of you. Let Jesus thank you for us!

Because of your giving, we:

- Raised over 7% of our 2024 half year givings amounting to ₦14,061,845.18
- Kept over 171 children in school in Nigeria and Ghana
- Onboarded one new missionary and supported some mission work in South Africa
- Supported New Converts with over 168 physical bibles in English, Yoruba, Hausa, and Arabic
- Recorded over 10,000 miracles of changed desires across Africa
- Assisted missionaries with Healthcare support

We were able to do all these through your support. However, there is more to be done, more grounds to cover, more lives to reach with the Gospel of our Lord Jesus, more languages for the Bible to be translated to and a host of other things. 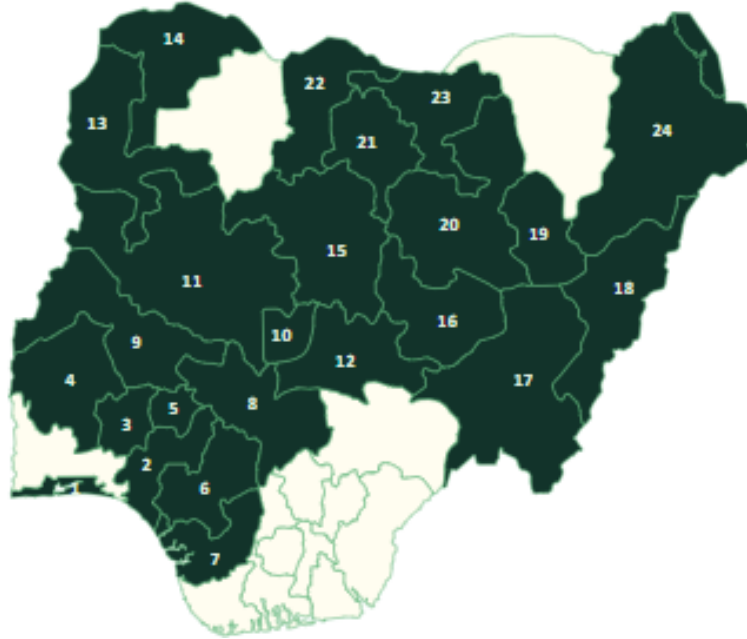

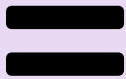

Missionaries' Praise Report

Pastor J

I want to begin by thanking God Almighty for all He is doing in my life and ministry through Missions One, Missions Ally Gospel Foundation, and all your amazing partners.

From January to June 2025, the support you consistently sent has empowered us to win souls, raise disciples, and bring light to communities otherwise untouched by the gospel. Your giving has truly made a difference, both spiritually and physically, in people's lives.

Breakdown of Support and Usage (January–June 2025)

January 2 – ₦31,000

- Paid a ₦10,000 hospital bill for Shuaibu, a convert from the Jikai community, whose family rejected him because of his new faith in Christ. This opened the door for the gospel in his family.
- Sent ₦5,000 to support another missionary.
- Used the remainder to support my family's needs.

February 3 - ₦52,827.47

- Sent ₦5,000 to a missionary.
- Bought blood tonic for an elderly woman suffering from anemia - she was healed, began walking again, and gave her life to Christ, opening her entire family to the gospel.
- Bought Fulcin tablets for a man with a long-term skin condition. He was healed before completing the dosage, which opened the door for ministry in his household.

March 4 – ₦43,817.39

- Gave ₦10,000 to help my disciple Isa settle his wife's hospital bill during childbirth.
- Donated blood and paid for our transportation to and from the hospital to support Isa and encourage him to remain strong in the Lord.
- This testimony touched the hearts of many women in Jikai, making them more open to the gospel.
- Visited the Takai community in Taura LGA, Jigawa State, where I met a man of peace, a potential open door for a future outreach.

April 2 – ₦47,593.50

- Sent ₦5,000 in support to a missionary.
- Bought ₦4,000 worth of foodstuffs for a disciple in Jikai community.
- Conducted a follow-up outreach in Yandomo community after the Missions 1 outreach - people are still open to the gospel.
- Received an Ajemi-language Bible, which is yielding powerful results in our ministry.

May 2 – ₦45,664.05

- Sent ₦5,000 to a missionary.
- Sponsored transportation for myself and Brother Shamsi from Jigawa to Kaduna and back for a missions conference.

June 2 – ₦51,143.71

- Sent ₦5,000 to a missionary.
- Purchased Fulcin tablets for two disciples with chronic skin conditions - both were healed.
- Bought:
 - 5kg upland rice seedlings (₦12,000), and distributed them to locals who had never seen such seeds before.
 - Ugwu (fluted pumpkin) and ginger seeds to encourage local farming and self-sustainability.

July 1 – ₦39,096.02

- ₦47,600 – Paid second term school fees for my three adopted children.
- ₦30,500 – Paid third term school fees for them.

Today, almost every household in the Jikai community is Christian, including several Fulani families. Praise be to God!

Visitors to my home often testify of God' s provision - some even regret refusing the call to missions because of fear of hardship, but now see God' s faithfulness at work. Many other miracles are taking place across northern states through this ministry: souls are saved, disciples are raised, the sick are healed, and the gospel is spreading steadily.

I want to offer special appreciation to Mission Ally Gospel Foundation. You are standing with us in every way. My prayer for you is from Psalm 34:10: "The young lions do lack, and suffer hunger: but they that seek the Lord shall not want any good thing." May you never lack any good thing, in Jesus' name. Thank you so much.

First and foremost, I give all the glory to God for His hand upon my life and ministry. I also want to deeply thank Missions 1 for their continued support and for connecting me to a sponsor - a woman I do not know personally, but whom God knows and is using mightily to touch lives.

From January to June 2025, I received financial support at various intervals. Although I do not receive bank alerts, I check my account balance occasionally, and I want to testify to how the Lord used this support to meet my needs and advance the work in the mission field.

Summary of Support Utilization

Total Amount Received: ₦280,189.13

Usage:

- The support came at a crucial time. Part of it was used to aid in the construction of our church, specifically for the purchase of doors and windows. It also helped cover essential personal needs such as food, healthcare, and clothing.
- During a difficult period, my mother was hospitalized, and the funds were instrumental in providing for her care. Later, my wife and child were involved in a serious car accident. Thankfully, they both survived and have fully recovered. The support helped cover their medical expenses and recovery needs.
- Additionally, I organized a Widows' Day event to minister to and encourage widows. I was also able to offer personal assistance to an elderly widow in need.
- The remaining funds were invested in agricultural inputs, specifically farming chemicals, to support ongoing farm work. A photo of this work is attached.

Ma'am, I want to say from the depths of my heart: thank you. I am truly happy for your support, but I know that our Lord Jesus is even happier. Because of your giving:

- The sick were healed
- A church building was raised
- Widows had their tears wiped away
- The hungry were fed

As the Bible says, "Whatever you do for the least of these, you do unto Me." You didn't just do it for me, you did it for Jesus Christ. He will surely call you a good and faithful servant. I pray that our Lord Jesus Christ will uplift you in every area of your life and continue to use you to touch more lives.

How the Support Received Was Utilized

1. **Educational Support (January):** Purchased writing materials and canvas shoes for children in our mission field (Primary 2–5) as schools resumed.
2. **Emergency Response (March):** Responded to an emergency after a Muslim convert was attacked on his way home from discipleship class in Malumfashi. I rushed him to the hospital with a team member and later housed him for recovery.
3. **Discipleship Training (April):** Organized a discipleship program in Gidan Bala, hosted at the Mai Uguwa residence.
4. **Widow Empowerment (April):** Assisted a widow with ₦25,000 to start a small business, helping her provide for her children and meet basic needs.
5. **Support for a Persecuted Family (May):** A Muslim convert and his family (wife and two children) began attending church secretly. After one service, their home was broken into and valuables, including cooking utensils, were stolen. Assisted the wife with ₦22,000 to replace cooking items. Gave the husband ₦12,000 to purchase clothes.
6. **Hospital Ministry (June):** Visited a Muslim woman who had been hospitalized due to shock after being divorced by her husband. I preached to her, and she gave her life to Christ on her hospital bed. Two days later, I returned and paid her medical bill of ₦17,500.
7. **Mission Training Program (June):** Organized a threeday program titled "Mission Training for MissionMinded People" in our church. Twelve people attended.
8. **Ongoing Outreach:** Every two weeks, our sixmember mission team embarks on outreaches. We hire a motorcycle to carry three people while I fuel my motorcycle and carry the remaining team members.

We are deeply grateful for the support that has enabled all of this. God bless you richly.

I am writing to express our sincere appreciation for the consistent financial support we have received from Mission Ally Gospel Foundation between January and June 2025. Below is a breakdown of how the support has been utilized. The financial assistance has been of immense help in the following areas:

1. **Rural Evangelism:** We have used the funds to carry out evangelistic outreaches in rural and unreached communities, preaching the gospel and discipling new converts.
2. **Education Support:** Some of the support was directed toward the payment of school fees for a number of our children, ensuring they stay in school and receive proper education.
3. **Family Welfare:** The support has also helped in meeting essential family needs, especially in the area of feeding.
4. **Widows Outreach Program:** Encouraged by your consistency, we launched a monthly outreach for widows. On the last day of every month, we gather over 100 widows for a time of preaching, discipleship, and fellowship. During each gathering, we provide them with meals and, when possible, share small gifts, made possible by your faithful support.

We remain deeply grateful to Mission Ally for your ongoing partnership in this Kingdom assignment. Your support is transforming lives and expanding the work of the gospel in our region. May God continue to bless and reward you abundantly.

Tanzania

Testimonies and How your support Contributed

1. During our mission outreaches to the Zaramo people in Kisarawe, we showed the Jesus Film, and by God's grace, more than 10 souls were saved. Many young people struggling with drug addiction—were also delivered, rehabilitated.
2. One of our secret Muslim converts has now gained the boldness to start attending church services openly.
3. Discipleship and missionary training are ongoing. Several trainees are maturing and now serving in local assemblies. So far, we have trained 9 indigenous missionaries; 5 of them are currently working among unreached people groups (UPGs) in Tanzania.
4. We got a piece of land within a predominantly Muslim community for church planting. We are now trusting God for the resources needed to begin building a worship center within the community.
5. One orphan girl has been adopted by my family, and we are taking care of her as part of our mission to reflect Christ's love.

Upcoming Activities - Next 6 months

1. **Community Jesus Film Shows** – We continue to conduct Jesus Film outreaches in local communities as an effective evangelistic tool to reach the unreached with the gospel of Christ.
2. **Widow and Orphans Outreaches** – Through these outreaches, we demonstrate Christ's love by supporting the less privileged with food items, essential supplies, and financial help.
3. **Mission Awareness Meetings** – We are organizing mission awareness gatherings to inspire and mobilize local churches and believers to actively engage in the Great Commission.
4. **Research on the "Wakami" People Group** – We are currently conducting research on an unreached people group known as the Wakami, seeking ways to adopt and reach them with the gospel.
5. **December Teenagers Camp Meeting** – In December, we are preparing to host over 100 teenagers from across the region for a 4-days camp meeting. This is a strategic effort to raise the next generation of committed believers and leaders in the land.

I write this report with a heart full of deep gratitude and reverence not just for what you've given, but for who you are to us. You are not just donors. You are co-laborers. You are intercessors. You are family. We call you *Mission Ally* not just for the sake of a name, but because that is truly who you are to the mission, our ally in the work of the gospel.

Over the past six months, your **consistent monthly giving** has been a wellspring of strength, encouragement, and impact. While we had many plans for 2025, the Lord, in His sovereign love, led us to focus on **outreaches and support** and over our own desires, we have chosen His will joyfully and wholeheartedly.

Total Amount Received: ₦761,141.12

Impact Through Education

Because of you, **26 children** have their **school fees paid**, some for an entire term, others for multiple terms, and some whose **backlog of debts was cleared**, restoring their access to education with dignity.

In **May**, your support helped us pay **₦175,000** in school fees for **13 children**. One of the most touching testimonies came from *Mrs. Vandi*, who wept as she explained that her daughter was about to be sent home for owing both second and third term fees. **Your giving turned her tears of worry into tears of joy.**

Impact Through the Word: Bibles for New Converts

In **April**, we received **₦275,000** which was used to purchase **50 full Bibles**, 25 in **English** and 25 in **Hausa** for our new converts. This was a **major need**, and because of your giving, many now hold the full Word of God in their own hands. Discipleship has become more fruitful because they can read, understand, and meditate on the Scriptures personally.

And there's more, when we went to purchase these Bibles, the bookstore owner, deeply moved by what we shared about our outreach, donated **100 New Testament Bibles**. We count this as a harvest from **your seed**. The **extra Bibles came because of your giving**. What a God!

Through this letter, we would like to share some updates from the mission field with you. First of all, we are deeply grateful for your continued support of the Lord's work.

We spent three weeks at the national office working on our first semester reports, planning for the second semester, and preparing our forecast for 2026. By the grace of God, everything went well. We also took part in a teaching program called the School of Ministry, with an anointed speaker, Pastor Moussa Dakida from Nigeria. It was a time of renewal for us.

By God's grace, our three Vigué pastors each now have a balafon—a traditional musical instrument highly cherished by the Vigué people—which will greatly support our evangelism efforts. We are planning a crusade for the last quarter of the year.

The translation work is progressing well too. We now have a few hymns in the local language. There are two types of translation: oral and written. The written translation is moving slowly, but orally, the Gospel of Luke is already available. We give thanks to God for this.

Once again, thank you for everything you do for us. May God reward you a hundredfold.

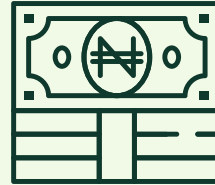

It is our prayer that God continually blesses you to support us to keep these children in school and give them a bright future through education.

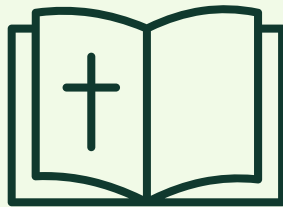

Project Bible Parcel



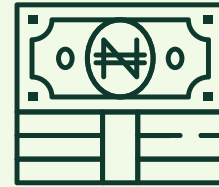
